2022 Federal Income Tax Credit Up To \$500*

For 2022, Congress reactivated tax credits for homeowners who make energy improvements to their primary residence. Tax credits are deducted from the total tax owed. You could reduce your tax payment up to \$500.

Qualifying Improvements	Required Criteria	Credit Amount
ATTIC INSULATION	Any insulation material or system designed to reduce heat loss or gain on a dwelling.	*10% off the material costs up to \$500. *Material cost is 75% of installed cost.
CENTRAL AIR CONDITIONING WITH ADVANCED CIRCULATORY FAN	Split Systems Minimum: 16 SEER / 13 EER Packaged Systems Minimum: 14 SEER / 12 EER	\$300 per system plus \$50 for advanced circulatory fan
HEAT PUMP WITH ADVANCED CIRCULATORY FAN	Split Systems Minimum: 15 SEER / 12.5 EER / 8.5 HSPF Packaged Systems Minimum: 14 SEER / 12 EER / 8.0 HSPF	\$300 per system plus \$50 for advanced circulatory fan
GAS FURNACE	Minimum: 95% AFUE	\$150 per furnace
WATER HEATERS	UEF \geq 0.82 OR 90% Thermal Efficiency	\$300 per water heater
